FINAL JUDGMENT AND ORDER

That on the 6th day of May 2021, the First and Final Report of Giovanni La Terra Bellina, Temporary and Permanent Receiver of St. Tony's LLC and LaSalle Service Station, Inc. came on for hearing, and the Court being satisfied that Notice of said Hearing has been given to all stockholders and creditors of the Respondents known to the Receiver, it is hereby:

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. That the Final Report of Giovanni La Terra Bellina, Temporary and Permanent Receiver herein, and all acts, doings, and disbursements of said Receiver are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified.

2. That the Recommendation on Allowance of Claims of St. Tony's LLC and the Recommendation on Allowance of Claims of LaSalle Service Station, Inc. filed herein by said Receiver are hereby approved.

3. That the secured claim of HarborOne Bank ("HarborOne") in the amount of Two Hundred Two Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Eight and 24/100 (\$202,158.24), plus interest, costs and reasonable attorney fees that was previously allowed, that the additional attorneys' fees and expenses of Leonard Accardo, Esq., from the previously allowed secured creditor claim of HarborOne Bank be allowed in the amount of One Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Five and 00/100 (\$1,575.00) and that the Receiver be authorized to pay said claim immediately..

4. That the Receiver's consolidated administrative claims in the amount of Fifty-Nine Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Two and 30/100 Dollars (\$59,192.30) related to the Respondents is hereby allowed, the Receiver is hereby authorized and directed to pay himself on account of said allowed administrative claims from the funds in the Receivership account.

5. That the administrative claim SJ Corio Company in the amount of Four Thousand One Hundred Twenty and 74/100 Dollars (\$4,120.74) related to the Respondents is hereby allowed and the Receiver is hereby authorized and the Receiver is hereby directed to pay SJ Corio Company on account of said allowed administrative claims from the funds in the Receivership account.

6. That the administrative claim of ClarkSilva in the amount of Four Thousand Three Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$4,300.00) is hereby authorized and the Receiver is hereby directed to pay ClarkSilva on account of said allowed administrative claims from the funds in the Receivership account.

7. That the administrative claim of Sweeney Real Estate & Appraisal in the amount of Twenty-Three Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty and 00/100 Dollars (\$23,820.00) is hereby allowed and the Receiver was authorized to pay said claim at the time of the closing on the sale of the Property.

8. That the administrative claim of Hoffman Engineering, Inc. in the amount of Twenty-Five Thousand Eight Hundred Five and 36/100 Dollars (\$25,805.36) is hereby allowed and the Receiver was authorized to pay said claim at the time of services being completed.

9. That the secured claim of the U.S. Small Business Administration be allowed in the amount of One Hundred Five Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Three and 43/100 (\$105,423.43) and that the Receiver be allowed to pay said claim with the remaining funds of the Receivership Estate.

10. That the Receiver is hereby directed to withhold Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) to satisfy and any and all remaining bills and carrying costs and obligations incurred during the pendency of the Receivership Estate and that without further application he is authorized to pay said outstanding obligations and distribute the balance

of the reserve proceeds and any additional funds that come into the possession of the Receiver to the U.S. Small Business Administration.

11. That said Receiver is hereby authorized to abandon all Respondent's books and records and any outstanding assets.

12. That said Receiver is hereby discharged and the Receivership Bond ordered cancelled.

13. That Respondent corporation is hereby ordered dissolved and the Receiver is directed to forward a copy of this Order to the Office of the Secretary of State for the State of Rhode Island.

14. That this proceeding is now closed and may be reopened only upon the filing of a Motion.
