ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we Lula A. Fowler, Mary C. Foster, Edith Mann, Lilly H. Johnston and Fannie L. Kirk

all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 212 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1909.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of Young Women's Christian Association of Pawtucket and Central Falls.

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of advancing the physical, social, mental and religious welfare of young women.

4th. Said corporation shall be located in the City of Pawtucket and in the City of Central Falls, Rhode Island.
