**ADDENDUM TO ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION**  
**OF**  
**K&N Lawn Service, LLC**

SIXTH: Additional provisions which the members elect to have set forth in these Articles of Organization:

(a) The company shall have the authority to guarantee any bonds, securities, or evidences of indebtedness created by; or dividends on; or a certain amount per share in liquidation of the capital stock of any corporation or other entity created by this state or by any other state, country, nation, or government, provided such corporation or other entity is formed for purposes similar to the purposes of this company or is engaged in the same or a substantially similar business or transacts business with this company or is owned or controlled by the same or substantially similar interests; but nothing herein contained shall authorize this company to carry on the business of a surety or indemnity company.

(b) The company shall have the authority to guarantee in any way permitted by law the performance of any of the contracts or other undertakings in which the company may otherwise be or become interested, of any corporation, association, partnership, firm, trustee, syndicate, individual, government, state, municipality, or other political or governmental division or subdivision, domestic or foreign, as may be permitted by law.

(c) The company shall have the authority to promote or assist, financially or otherwise, corporations, syndicates, partnerships, trusts, trustees, individuals, or associations of all kinds, and to give any guaranty in connection therewith for the payment of money or for the performance of any obligation or undertaking.

(d) Section 7-16-21 of the Rhode Island General Laws (1956), as amended, regarding written consents of members is hereby adopted.

(e) The company, or any subsidiary or affiliated company thereof, shall indemnify and hold harmless each person (and his heirs, administrators, and executors) who shall serve at any time hereafter as a member of the company or any subsidiary or affiliated company thereof from and against any and all claims and liabilities to which such person shall become subject by reason of his having heretofore or hereafter been a member of the company or any subsidiary or affiliated company thereof, or by reason of any action alleged to have been heretofore or hereafter taken or omitted by him as such member and shall reimburse each such person for all legal and other expenses reasonably incurred by him in connection with any such claim of liability; provided, however, that no such person shall be indemnified against or be reimbursed for any expense incurred in connection with any claim or liability arising out of his own gross negligence or willful misconduct. The rights accruing to any person under the foregoing provisions of this Article shall not exclude any other right to which he may be lawfully entitled, nor shall anything herein contained restrict the right of the company to indemnify or reimburse such person in any proper case even though not specifically herein provided for. The company, its members shall be fully protected in taking any action or making any payment under this Article, or in refusing so to do, in reliance upon the advice of counsel.

(f) No single member acting alone shall have the power or authority to bind the Company to any contract with a third party unless such contract has been approved by the members.
